

Practical Skills Test

A practical skills test involves guiding the applicant (individually or in a group) through a practical task to see how they perform. A practical skills test can be used to check skill levels and ability in:

- use of safe work practices
- assessing risk
- technical capabilities
- use of computers
- teamwork skills
- listening and following instruction.

A practical skills test also provides a good opportunity to observe what attitude applicants display when they take on a task (for example their enthusiasm).
